		<p>purposes of this rule." <i>Id.</i> "[T]hat a document was produced in discovery pursuant to a protective order has no bearing on the presumption of access that attaches when it becomes a judicial document." <i>Collado v. City of New York</i>, 193 F. Supp. 3d 286, 28990 (S.D.N.Y. 2016) (citing to <i>Raffaele v. City of New York</i>, No. 13-cv-4607, 2014 WL 2573464, at *2 (E.D.N.Y. June 9, 2014)). Not all of the information Plaintiffs seek to seal is entitled to sealing. For example, an entire deposition is not entitled to sealing because it contains some references to protected information, such as a child's name. In such a circumstance, counsel should produce a public version that seals only the information entitled to sealing. That is the only way for sealing to be narrowly tailored, as required. In addition, the motion does not indicate how Exhibits E and F contain proprietary information aside from the conclusory claim that they do, nor does it explain how having access to this information could compromise Plaintiffs' computer networks integrity. Lastly, the agreement Plaintiffs' cite to as a basis for sealing Exhibit H is not a court order protecting the exhibit as confidential and entitled to sealing, and it is a misrepresentation to suggest it does so. Therefore, the motion to seal is denied. The Court will afford these documents sealed status for 7 days. During that time Plaintiffs may move to seal only those portions entitled to sealing to be accompanied by a memorandum of law establishing the clear and compelling reasons that justify sealing. Plaintiffs' counsel is ordered to show cause within 7 days as to why he should not be sanctioned for filing what amounts to be meritless motion to seal that has effectively wasted the Court's time.
