SCHEDULE A

(Descriptions of Properties to be Searched)

- 1. The real property and premises known as 1922
 Marengo Street, New Orleans, Louisiana, is the residence of
 Congressman William J. Jefferson, more particularly described as
 a two-story, white with baby blue trim, family dwelling IownHouse
 with a front portico addition with door columns and six windows
 above the porch. This residence is located on the southeast
 corner of the intersection of Marengo and Dryades Screet. On the
 ground-level of this two-story building is a single door on the
 porch with a window to its left. When facing the residence,
 there is a paved drive-way used for parking to the left. There
 is likely a side and/or back entrance to the residence, but an
 actual visual of these entrance was not obtained.
- The real property and premises known as the Office Swetland and Childress, Certified Public Accountants, 650 Poydras Street, Suite 2245, New Orleans, Louisiana 70130, more particularly described as being situated on the 22nd floor of a gray 28-story building constructed of concrete. The front entrance of this building contained the address, "650 Poydras," and name of the building "Poydras Plaza," which faces Poydras Street. This building is located to the northeast corner of the intersection of Poydras and Camp Street. There is a parking lot that faces the Federal Courthouse on the Camp Street side of the building. A marque on the lobby level of this building noted that "Swetland and Childress" was located in Suite 2245. Suite 2245 is secured by a solid wooden door, and there is a door-sized window to the left of the door. This window conceals the room behind it with closed blinds. The window contained the numbers "2245" scribed in white on its face. The margue in the lobby also listed "Jefferson Interests" as an occupant of Suite 2245.
