WHEREAS, the Plaintiff-claiming Authority (the "District Attorney") has previously commenced this civil forfeiture action styled Robert M. Morgenthau, District

Attorney of New York County, Plaintiff-Claiming Authority v. L. Dennis Kozlowski and Mark

H. Swartz, Index Number 403698/02 (the "Forfeiture Action"); and

WHEREAS, on September 10, 2002, the Honorable William J. Davis granted a temporary restraining order restraining defendant L. Dennis Kozlowski ("Kozlowski") and all persons or entitics having property of Kozlowski in their possession from removing, transferring, assigning, disposing of, encumbering and/or securing any legal, equitable, custodial or beneficial interests that Kozlowski has on any real or personal property wherever located, or whether jointly or individually held, or in any debts owed to Kozlowski, to the extent of Six Hundred Million Dollars (\$600,000,000,000.00) (the "TRO"); and

WHEREAS, on September 19, 2005, Kozlowski was sentenced to a prison term totaling 8 ½ to 25 years, and ordered to pay restitution in the amount of \$97,778,296 and a fine in the amount of \$70,000,000 by September 19, 2006; and

WHEREAS, Kozlowski and the District Attorney previously entered into an Agreement, dated December 19, 2005, to address the payment of the fine and the restitution Amount; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to an order of this Court, dated November 17, 2006, Kozlowski entered into an agreement with Tyco and others (the "Restitution Agreement") where Kozlowski agreed to transfer the full amount of restitution to Tyco on January 2, 2007, and \$97,778,296 has been transferred to Tyco; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Agreement, Kozlowski has now paid the full amount of the fine into an escrow account established and held by the District Attorney at JPMorgan Chase Bank, N.A., 1 Chase Manhattan Plaza, 21<sup>st</sup> Floor, New York, New York 10081, Account No. [REDACTED], titled DANY-LDK, Bank Routing Number [REDACTED] (the "Escrow Account"); and

WHEREAS, in light of these facts, Kozlowski's counsel advised the District

Attorney that Kozlowski would be seeking an order vacating the TRO and dismissing the

Forfeiture Action; and

WHEREAS, the District Attorney has no objection to that relief; and IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED AND AGREED THAT:

- 1. The Forfeiture Action is hereby dismissed as to Kozlowski, without prejudice.
  - 2. The TRO is hereby vacated as to Kozlowski.

The amount of the Fine shall remain in the Escrow Account, pursuant to 3. the terms of the December 19, 2005 Agreement between the District Attorney and Kozlowski.
